



Position: Animal Caregiver - General
Reports to: Animal Caregiver Supervisor

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: Caring for all aspects of dog, cat and farmed animal care at Pasado's Safe Haven (PSH). Caregivers work closely with Animal Caregiver Leads, Animal Caregiver Supervisor, Sanctuary Director, Volunteer and Adoption Coordinators and Veterinary staff to ensure the physical and emotional well-being of all animals at the sanctuary.

Responsibilities:

- Feed and care for the animals in the area of the sanctuary assigned per direction of Leads and Vet Staff
 - Ensure all living environments are clean and safe
 - Provide enrichment based on established protocols
 - Help with special projects
- Work with Animal Care Supervisor, vet staff and other appropriate staff to ensure proper medical attention is given to all animals
 - Alert ALL staff and veterinarian of any concerns or needs with animals; consult with Animal Caregiver Supervisor and vet staff for specific veterinary follow-up for animals.
 - Assist on-site veterinarian and vet tech as needed.
- Actively participate in volunteer training program
 - Work collaboratively with volunteers to ensure they have a positive experience
 - Train volunteers as needed and support them as they donate time around the sanctuary.
- Work with Volunteer Coordinator to ensure animals are prepared for off-site adoption events including feeding, medicating, bathing, grooming, cleaning eyes, etc. before leaving sanctuary.

Other duties:

- Engage with and support volunteers working in your area.
- Support sanctuary tours and other special events as needed.
- Assist with special projects as needed.
- Participate in rescues and disaster relief as needed.
- If living onsite, must be willing to bring sick or special needs animals in with you at night

Required Skills/Qualifications

- Some experience working with/caring for animals in a shelter or sanctuary environment preferred
- Valid WA drivers' license required

The best candidate will be:

- Passionate about animal welfare/rescue
- Optimistic and solution-oriented
- Able to maintain a positive, professional attitude in challenging situations

- Organized and detail-oriented
- Able to work successfully with a variety of different skill sets and personalities
- A proactive communicator who is comfortable setting and maintaining high standards
- Respectful, compassionate and patient with animals, volunteers and co-workers
- Able to successfully prioritize and manage multiple projects/tasks simultaneously
